<sup>1</sup>**Crash:** An event that produces injury and/or property damage, involves a motor vehicle in transport, and occurs on a trafficway or while the vehicle is still in motion after running off the trafficway.

<sup>2</sup>**AOD-Related Crash:** A crash that involves an alcohol- and/or drug-impaired driver.

<sup>3</sup>**All Drivers:** This category is comprised of crashes involving drivers of any age. These numbers may not equal the sum of crashes for each age group (age 16-20 and age 21+) because one crash may involve drivers from both age groups who would therefore be counted in both age group columns but only once in the "All Drivers" column. There may also be crashes involving drivers under age 16 that are included in the "All Drivers" column.

<sup>4</sup>**Fatal Crash:** A police-reported crash involving a motor vehicle in transport on a trafficway in which at least one person dies within 30 days of the crash.

<sup>5</sup>**Injury Crash:** A police-reported crash that involves a motor vehicle in transport on a trafficway in which no one died but at least one person was reported to have: (1) an incapacitating injury; (2) a visible but not incapacitating injury; (3) a possible, not visible injury; or (4) an injury of unknown severity.

<sup>6</sup>**All Crashes:** This category includes fatal crashes, injury crashes, and property damage only crashes (not included in this table).
